4. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

No Target Oil Bottle is a mineral oil to be used for freeing animals accidentally trapped by adhesive traps.

5. HOW TO USE:

In order to promote careful use of glue traps and accurate management of monitoring stations, we always recommend following the "Best Practice" protocol for using adhesive traps. In the event that an unwanted animal accidentally gets stuck in one of these devices, we recommend using No Target Oil Bottle by following these steps:

- 1. Equip yourself with gloves, a towel, some fabrics, a damp cloth, and a secure container or a shoebox with air holes.
- 2. Cut the spout of the lid near the tip (about 2 mm).
- 3. Put on the gloves and calm the animal by covering its head with a towel.
- 4. Pour a small amount of oil onto the adhesive surface where the animal is stuck and gently massage the area until the animal is free from the glue. Ensure to keep the amount of oil to a minimum, as it can interfere with the animal's natural waterproofing, reducing its chances of survival after release.
- 5. Once the animal is free from the glue trap, cover the trap carefully with a tissue to prevent the animal from getting stuck again.
- 6. Use a damp cloth to clean the excess oil from the animal and place it in a box with air holes.
- 7. Cover the container with the towel to darken it and place it in a quiet and warm place so the animal can rest for an hour or two.
- 8. Release the animal into the wild or take it to a wildlife rehabilitator. Active and alert animals can be released outdoors during mild weather within a block radius from where they were found. If the animal was trapped during extreme weather (storm, heavy rainfall, severe drought, etc.), it should be taken to a wildlife rehabilitator.
- 9. If you are unable to remove the animal from the adhesive surface or if it is lethargic or injured, immediately take it to a veterinarian or a wildlife rehabilitator. You can also call the wildlife rescue center (CRAS) in your region for advice.

Storage conditions: in a cool and dry room, temperature below 25°C and R.H. below 55%. The mineral oil, over time, does not lose its physical properties and its characteristic viscosity, therefore it is not fixed an expiration date.
